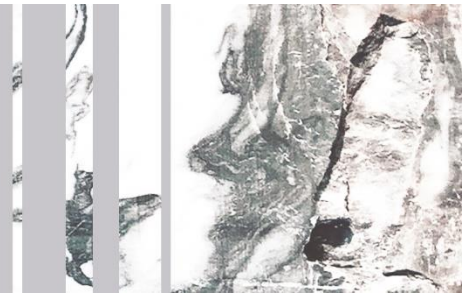


EXODUS

GOD IS NEAR

Exodus 37-40



READING/DISCUSSION

Read **Exodus 40:34-38**.

- How did this sermon/text deepen your faith? How did it challenge you? Explain.
- What did this passage teach you about God? What did it teach you about yourself?
- Share a time when you've waited on God and moved when he said to move. Share a time when you didn't wait on God and moved before he said to move. What was the difference between these two experiences?
- In what situation are you currently waiting on God to give you guidance to move? What has the waiting been like for you?
- When it comes to building our lives, God has the master blueprints. What work does God want to accomplish in your life this season? What plans do you think he has?
- God's glory is like weightiness. When God's glory comes down, he displaces everything and everyone. Has there been a time or experience in your life when you sensed the glory of God in a profound way?
- How big of a measuring device are you bringing to God these days?
- Glory can be understood as an expression of beauty. Are you taking time to appreciate God's beauty? Or are you just rushing past it with your eyes focused on other things?
- Dan gave four different examples of how we can respond to direction. Which do you find yourself operating out of most often?
- When it comes to direction, Dan talked about the difference between things feeling forced or free, and the difference between isolation and community. How have you seen this in your own life?
- How does this passage, sermon, or daily work challenge you to live differently?
- Looking back, what was the most impactful lesson God taught you during the Exodus series? What was the most significant work God accomplished in you?

ENCOURAGEMENT

- What do you sense God doing in you that you need to respond to?
- What do you sense God doing around you that you think he is inviting you into?
- What do you sense God doing through you that you need courage for?

ACCOUNTABILITY

At this time, the group may want to split into smaller, gendered groups.

- Who are you in God's eyes? Who are you in the eyes of this group?
- What has your time in God's Word and prayer been like this week?
- What have you learned from Exodus 37-40 this week?

- How have you loved God and loved others this week?
- Where have you wrestled with temptation this week?
- What strongholds have you wrestled with this week?
